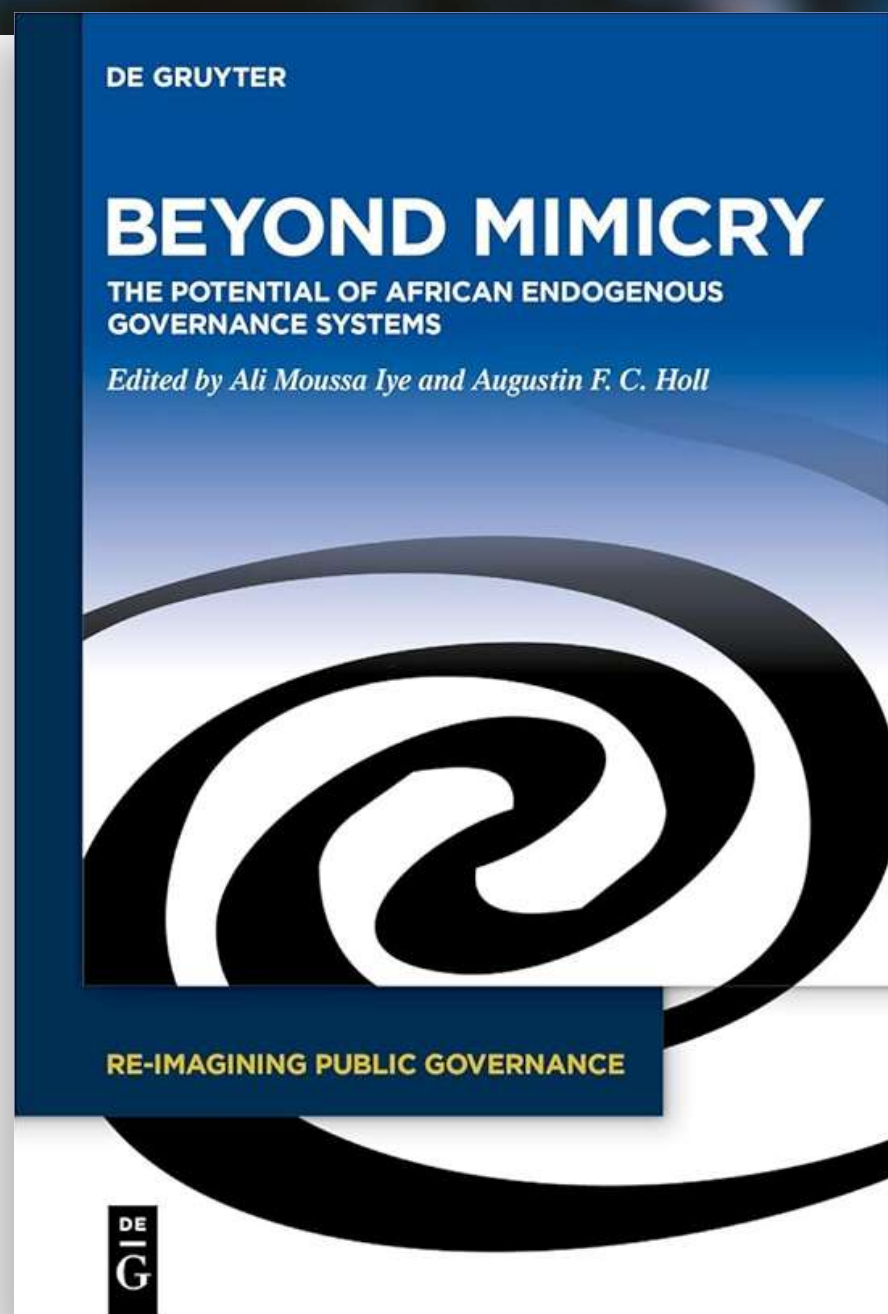


BOOK LAUNCH
